Modification History

Release 1. Renamed qualification merges the existing Certificate III in Clothing and Textile Production and Certificate III in Applied Fashion Design and Technology which already shared a large number of units. Overall number of units reduced by one to account for some merging of units. Core units changed, including addition of industry-specific sustainability, communication and sewing units. Named specialisations removed. Unused digital embroidery and digital printing content removed. Small business electives added.

Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work in production-related roles in the textile, clothing and footwear industry. Individuals may be self-employed or work in small or large organisations. They use specialised knowledge of apparel or textile production processes and apply discretion, judgement and problem-solving skills to achieve work outcomes and take responsibility for their own work. Individuals may have some limited responsibility for the work of others.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

Total number of units = 18

- 6 core units
- 12 elective units, consisting of:
 - at least 6 units from Group A
 - 6 additional units from Groups A, B, any endorsed Training Package or accredited course – all units must be relevant to the work outcome.
